Albion in the Community is launching a new FA Talent Centre and we are looking for talented players aged 10 or above who are classified blind (B1) or partially sighted with very low vision and deteriorating eye condition (B2).

Players can come from any setting, but must meet the appropriate classification criteria (AITC can support with this process).

The FA Regional Talent Centres offer opportunities for players to progress on the FA's Emerging Talent Pathway with the potential to achieve full England International status.

We will be holding a Disability Talent Day on Wednesday 26th August which is open to all players who would like more information or to try out for the centres.

We then have 2 open trial dates in September, Saturday 12th (daytime) and Wednesday 23rd (evening).
